West Berkshire District Council jointly with Oxfordshire County Council **PROPOSES** to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to impose a 20 M.P.H. speed limit as follows

**IN THE PARISHES OF PANGBOURNE AND WHITCHURCH**  
**20 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT**

B471 Whitchurch Road, Pangbourne, Whitchurch Bridge and High Street, Whitchurch.	From a point 205 metres north of the junction with High Street Pangbourne (co-terminus with the existing 20 speed limit Pangbourne) to a point 240 metres further north (At the end of the property owned by the Whitchurch Bridge Company)

When the Order is made these roads will no longer be Restricted Roads as defined by Section 82(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

No statutory provision imposing a speed limit on motor vehicles shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion

No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

This Order is necessary to reduce the speed limit on the privately owned Whitchurch Toll Bridge so that it is consistent with the existing 20 m.ph. speed limit in Pangbourne, reduces the speed across the bridge and improves road safety

West Berkshire District Council in conjunction with Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of powers contained in Sections 84(1) and (2) to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 201[ ] and may be cited as the **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL B471 WHITCHURCH ROAD PANGBOURNE, WHITCHURCH BRIDGE AND HIGH STEET WHITCHURCH (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) AND (DERESTRICTION) ORDER 201[ ]**
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 20 M.P.H. on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
4. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle or vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 if that vehicle or vehicles is/are being used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
5. The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act

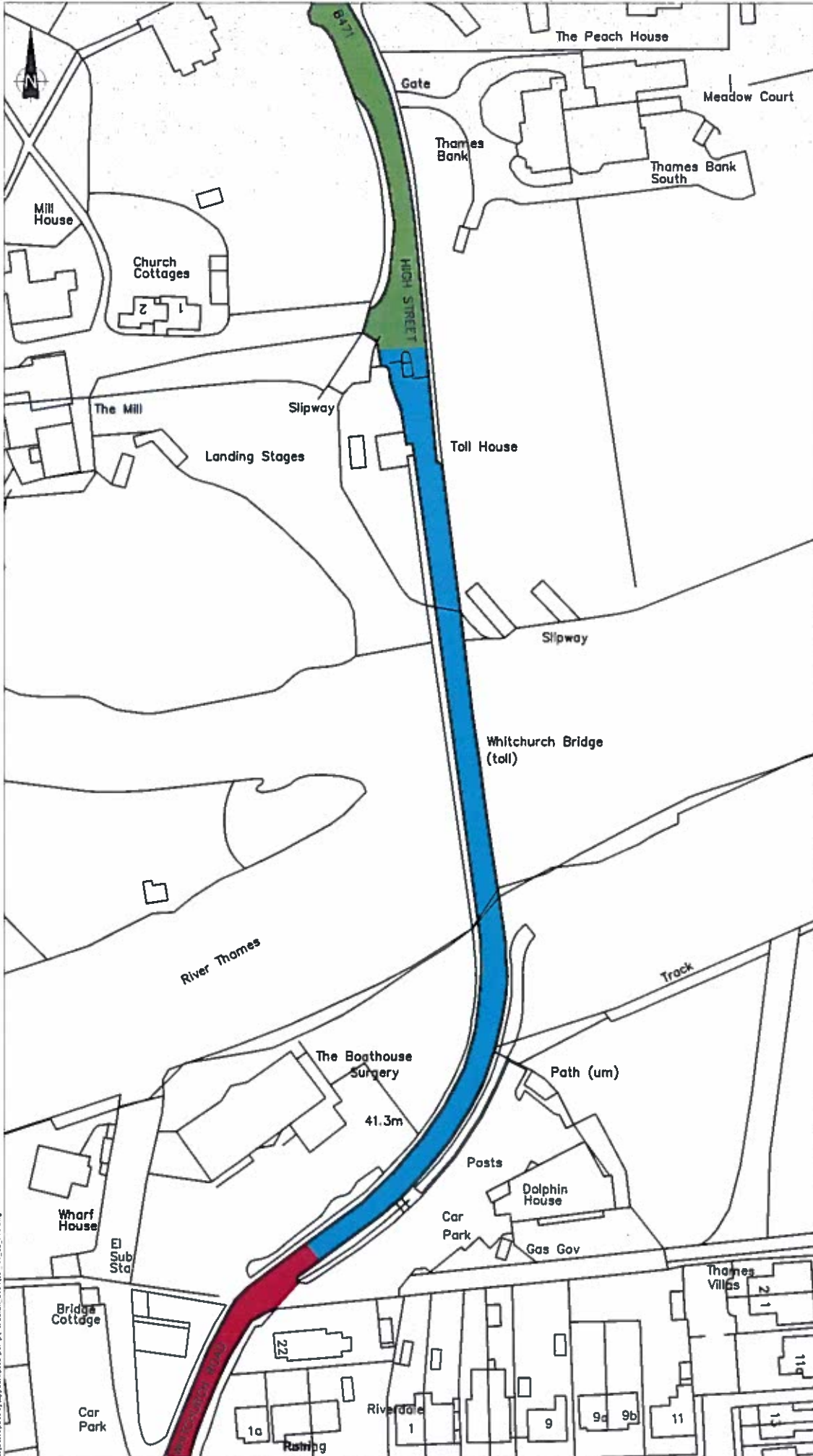
