

Village Fete 2017

On **Saturday 2nd September** the annual Whitchurch Village Fete will take place on the village green **from 2 to 5 pm**. There is loads of fun and activities on offer for all ages!

There will be a craft activity - creating pom poms - and the Beenham Wind Orchestra will be playing throughout the afternoon.

Pimms, Prosecco and Strawberries and Cream will also be on offer, as well as a barbecue. Tutt's Clump cider and Horsebox waffles will be there selling their delicious food and drink. Further up the field you will find a brilliant range of stalls from gorgeous jewellery, to interiors, to hand-made gifts, to well known health and beauty brands and many more. Our local community organisations will also be in attendance so you can catch up on important village matters. The RSPB is bringing a display - one for nature enthusiasts not to miss!

We will be holding our first Hobby Horse Gymkhana too, and the fete will close with the annual tug of war and Grand Prize Draw.
