

Hardwick Road Verges project moves ahead

The Hardwick Road Verges project received a welcome boost this week. WoTHabs were delighted with the news that the Parish Council have agreed to provide some funding to help pay for the next proposed stage of work. The plan is to restore sections of the verges by building up with new soil to halt the progressive erosion caused by vehicles. These new areas will then be seeded with a locally-sourced grass and wildflower mix. Wooden bollards will be positioned strategically to protect the restored verges from further damage. The aim is to achieve a balance between the bio-diversity and the amenity value of the verges, and all the users of the road, but without causing difficulty for motorists. When the verge restoration work is completed, WoTHabs plan to improve the access to the verge on the south side, so that it is possible to walk safely and comfortably off the road all the way from the village to the Hardwick Estate gates.
