

There are two vacancies at the Goring Heath Almshouses



The Almshouses at Goring Heath are a group of sheltered homes where retired, or soon to retire, people over age 60 can live on an independent basis.

We offer a welcoming community, beautiful grounds that include their own Chapel, Common Room, guest room, parking and allotments. There is a Warden and Chaplain who have homes in the grounds.

Each unfurnished almshouse comprises of a centrally heated and newly decorated home, with a bedroom, sitting room, kitchen and bathroom.

It is a requirement that applicants (single or couples) must be of good character with limited means, are capable of independent living, have resided in the local area for the last two years and can demonstrate that they have need of an Almshouse.

Residents are appointed by the Trustees of The Allnutt & Baker Almshouse and Educational Trust as a beneficiary of the Charity and pay a weekly maintenance charge instead of rent, along with a fuel contribution.

Applicants should apply to the address below in writing giving background details and if the initial criteria are met, an application form will be sent.
