Vacancy for a Parish Councillor

This is a voluntary position and requires a minimum of one evening a month to attend Parish Council meetings, currently the second Thursday of the month and held in the Village Hall. You may choose to focus on specific areas that will require you investigate issues and meet with stakeholders in the village or externally. Councillors bring local issues to the attention of the council, help it make decisions on behalf of the local community, and represent the views of residents within and outside the village.

The key requirements are that councillors have a minimum age of 18, are on the electoral role, and a citizen of the UK, Commonwealth, EU or Ireland. They must be a resident of the village or within 3 miles of the parish, own land or work in the parish.

We are looking for people who are interested in local issues with a willingness to represent the views of the whole community in a professional and effective manner.
