this is my first email as team vicar of Whitchurch and I'm sending it to all those who have previously been receiving the Rev'd Kevin's weekly emails. You may have seen me on Zoom by now, but I'm sorry if I haven't been able to meet you face to face yet. I do look forward to meeting everyone as soon as it becomes possible. These are testing times, but I do hope and pray we can all know God as our rock, our fortress, and our deliverer (Psalm 18:2). I'm sure you're wanting to know what's next as far as our worship at Whitchurch is concerned, so here's a quick update for you:

After meeting with the churchwardens and PCC, I'm very pleased to be able to say that we'll be starting online (Zoom) services for Whitchurch on Sunday November 15th at 11.00 am and I'll be sending out the details for that next week. Government restrictions permitting we are then planning to open St. Mary's for worship from Sunday December 6th at 9.30 am. There are still a lot of unknowns around Christmas and inevitably things will be different this year, but we are looking at creative ways of making it as full of 'comfort and joy' as possible.

Finally, this Sunday is Remembrance Sunday and while there will be no church service in Whitchurch or Whitchurch Hill, there will be online services hosted by other ministers in the team (see further below). As an alternative you might consider going to your doorstep at 11.00 am on Sunday to observe the two minutes' silence. There will be wreaths laid at the War Memorial but attendance this year is being limited to those directly involved in the wreath laying.
